## ***INTRODUCTION & TARGET AUDIENCE***

The Tennessee Board of Pharmacy requires that one-half (15 hours) of the required 30 hours of continuing education every two years, must be live. The 2009 "Pharmacy Update" will provide a total of 15 "live" hours. You may register for either day alone, providing 8 live-hours of CE for the *Drug Update* or 7 live-hours of CE for the *General & Legal Update*.

The 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual "Pharmacy Update" is intended to provide the opportunity for pharmacists and pharmacy technicians to be informed of recent changes, present challenges and future opportunities affecting drug therapy and pharmacy practice. The *Drug Update* session is designed to keep all pharmacists and pharmacy technicians up-to-date on the recent introduction of new drugs and changes with existing drugs. The *General & Legal Update* session will discuss the new laws and regulations affecting practice, as well as legislative action and practice issues.

## ***EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES***

The overall goal of this knowledge-based CPE activity is to update the participant to changes and advances made during 2008 that have affected pharmacy practice and to look at what is happening in 2009.
